To help your evening run smoothly, we ask you to follow the directions listed below:

- Remove your children immediately from parking lot area and go directly to the entrance of the zoo. If you will be waiting for additional children to arrive, please have a prearranged waiting area. The pumpkin patch is perfect. (Any area by the parking lot is prohibited.)
- Each child/adult must be wearing a wristband before entering the zoo.
- Upon entering the zoo, pick a campfire or picnic table for your group's designated meeting area.
- At the end of the evening, we ask that everyone exit through the "group exit." Upon leaving, everyone will receive a free pie pumpkin, compliments of the Johansen family.

A few things to remember:

- The zoo is surrounded by corn stalks and no child is permitted to leave without an adult. Therefore, your children are in a safe environment.
- Noah's Miniature Golf Course, the corn maze, animal area, hay ride and the 2-story air slides are open all evening. If there is a line at any of these attractions, we suggest you try something else and return later. There will be plenty of time to do everything.
- We encourage you to use our campfires - just bring your sticks and marshmallows or hot dogs! As hot water is not available on premises, we suggest you bring your own hot chocolate, or you may purchase some at our concession stand.
- Our concession stand & donut shop's regular hours will be extended for this event.
- Kids like to use flashlights in the "Amazing Corn Maze."
- Feed for the animals is 25 cents. (Sorry, no outside feed is allowed.)
- Make sure you dress appropriately for the weather.
- Campfires are shared in order to allow you to get to know other troops.
